HORSEBACK RIDING

Riders of all skill levels can enjoy over 50 miles of beautiful horseback riding trails with corral lessons or lead around rides for the kids.

HORSEBACK RIDING

Rides are limited. Please sign up in advance. Meet at the barn 15 minutes prior to your ride. Wear closed-toe shoes. Stampede strings required for full-brimmed hats. Helmets available upon request and required for under 18 years of age.

Group and Private Horseback Rides

Our experienced wranglers will lead you on a scenic ride along our 50 miles of winding trails. Rides are grouped based on skill level: beginner, intermediate, or advanced. For guests 7+ years of age. One and two hour rides available. (Two-person minimum for private rides). Reservation required.

Corral Lessons

Introduce your kids to horseback riding in a safe environment where they can develop a love for riding and experience the ranch lifestyle. For guests 4-6 years of age. Lesson is 30 minutes. Private lessons available. Reservation required.

Lead Around Ride

For your child's first time in the saddle, start with a gentle lead around ride guided by a wrangler. For guests up to 6 years of age. Parental supervision is required and no reservation is necessary.

The Starter Ride

This one-hour ride is perfect for novice riders. Reservation required.

The Distance Ride

At approximately three hours, this ride allows avid riders to see parts of the Ranch not normally explored during our other trail rides. Gallop the trails and see the farthest views we have to offer. Reservation required.

Barrel and Arena Lessons

Let our experienced wranglers increase your riding skills. Arena lessons for riders 7+ years of age and barrel lessons are for riders 12+ years of age with intermediate to advanced riding skills. Private lessons available. Reservation required.

Ride to Adobe Breakfast

An Alisal signature and perennial guest favorite! Ride a horse to our historic Adobe and enjoy a full breakfast before returning via horseback. Hay wagon transportation to breakfast is also available. Reservation required.

Private Picnic Ride

Experience a perfect blend of an enchanted riding adventure with soaring vistas and outdoor dining. This three-hour excursion includes a picnic enjoyed either lakeside or at our historic Adobe. Suitable for riders of all levels, this is a "walk only" ride. Reservation required.

The Alisal boasts two stunning 18-hole professional golf courses for your enjoyment. The Ranch Course offers breathtaking views of the surrounding mountains and a challenging course layout, making it a favorite among golf enthusiasts. The River Course, with its serene landscaping and lush fairways, provides a perfect blend of natural beauty and a relaxing golf experience for players at all levels. Both Courses feature a Grill & Golf Lounge, Pro Shop, putting green, and practice areas and are conveniently located just up the road from the Guest Ranch. Private and group instruction is available at both Courses as well. Carts and clubs are available for rent. Appropriate golf attire and shoes required.

Ranch Course

Designed by the legendary Billy Bell, Jr., our 6,550-yard, par-72 Ranch Course opened in 1956 exclusively for our guests and club members. This beautiful course was designed around an imposing barranca that winds through it surrounded by venerable oaks, pines, sycamores, and eucalyptus trees. It is known for its tight fairways and is an excellent challenge for the seasoned golfer.

River Course

Opened in 1992, our 6,800-yard, par-72 River Course is located along the Santa Ynez River offering sweeping vistas of the fairways and the majestic Santa Ynez Mountains. The strategic placement of a variety of hazards rewards length and accuracy without severely penalizing recreational golfers. It is open to the public and ideal for beginners as well as families.

TENNIS & PICKLEBALL

Enjoy a traditional game of tennis or check out pickleball - one of fastest growing sports in the U.S.! We offer five full-size tennis courts and four pickleball courts with everything you need to learn the sport or advance your skills. Court times may be reserved in advance; clinics and private lessons are available. Visit our full-service Tennis Shop for gear, clothing and accessories.

Experience a family-friendly hike with our naturalist. This 1.5 hour hike around our 100-acre lake focuses on local flora, fauna, and the history of the Ranch. Sun protection recommended, closed-toe shoes required. For ages 8+, guests under 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Reservation required.

Hiking Trail

A 2.8 mile loop for all skill levels. Average hike time is 1.5 hours. The trailhead is located a short ways up the Lake Road. Check out our Field Guide available under Hiking on our website. Great views of the Valley!

Ropes Course

Experience the thrill of an aerial obstacle course. For ages 7+, guests under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Reservation required.

Tie Dye

Create a fun t-shirt design using colorful dyes at the Laurel Room.

Experience the beauty and serenity of our 100-acre, spring-fed private lake. Take a boat out for early morning fishing or simply throw a line off the dock. Enjoy paddleboarding, archery, air rifle, and axe throwing - all with a view!



LAKE ACTIVITIES

Lake Shuttle

Experience our private lake! The shuttle picks up hourly behind the playground at the lake shuttle stop. Guests may not drive, walk or bike to the lake. Reservation not required.

Boating and Fishing

Try your hand at fishing for largemouth bass and bluegill. Lake staff is available to assist. Catch-and-release only. Fishing poles and bait are complimentary. No advance reservation needed for boats.

Guided Fishing Trip

Book a two-hour trip with one of our experienced guides. Beginners will learn how to tie knots, cast, choose tackle, and identify various types of fish. The fly-fishing trip has a two person maximum and spin fishing has a three person maximum. Reservation required 7 days in advance.

Archery and Air Rifle Combo Class

Hone your marksmanship skills alongside our experienced instructors. Closed-toe shoes required. For guests 8+ years of age. Reservation required.

Axe Throwing

Engage in the unique thrill of axe throwing! Learn proper technique, grip, stance, and throwing motion from our knowledgeable instructors. For guests 10+ years of age. Closed-toe shoes required. Reservation required. A full axe throwing lane may also be reserved for 4-6 people.

Dinner

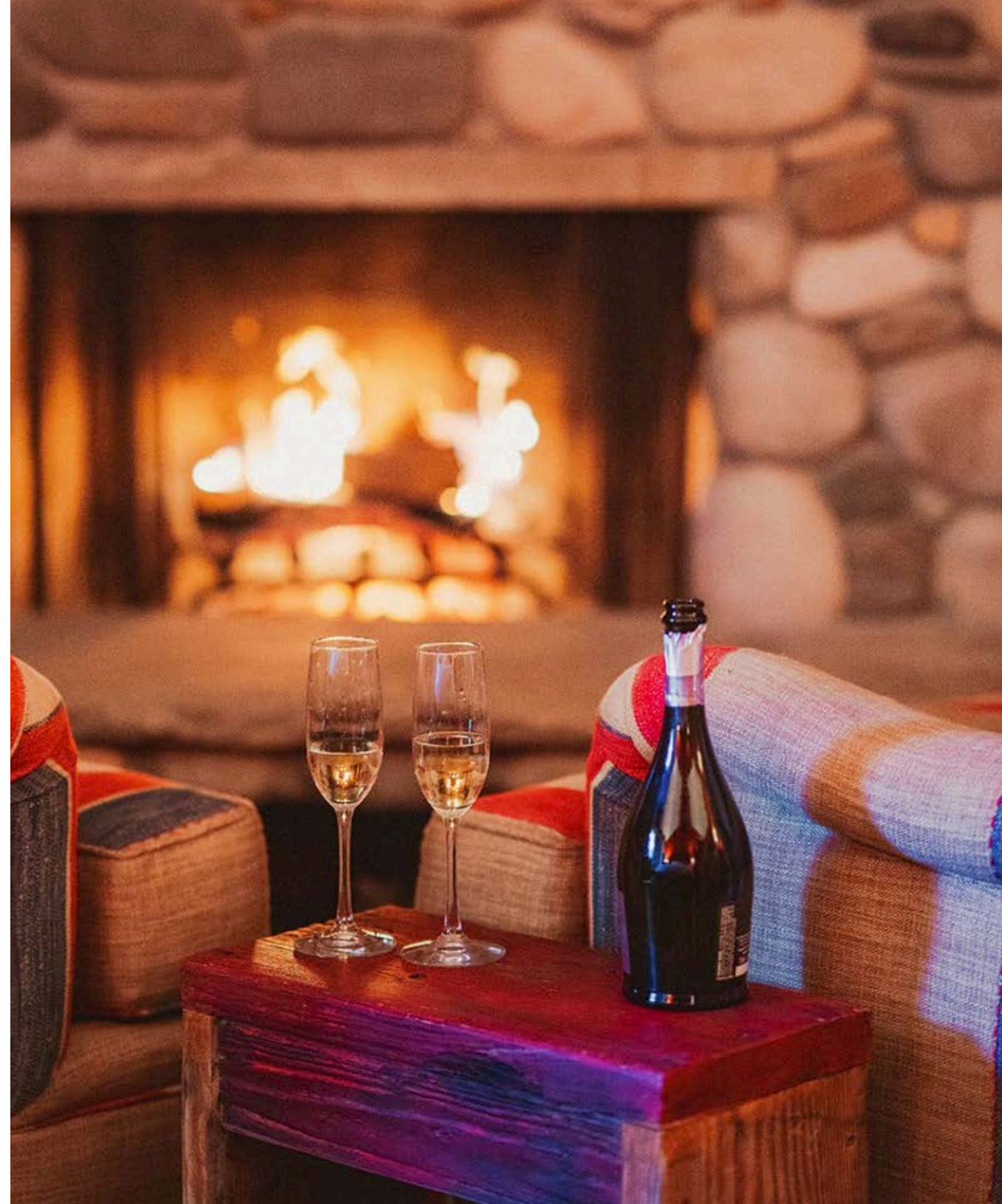

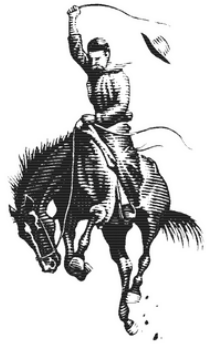
